Targets may be cross-registered with the ATA. Shooters wishing to do so must shoot their longest yardage and are subject to membership and fees of both associations. Shooters must declare their cross registration before shooting the first event. Registration may not be changed once you start shooting.

Shooters – keep all guns open and unloaded when not on the firing line.

Lunch will be served.

Keep all dogs leashed and away from trap fields.

Overnight parking for self-contained RV's available at \$20 per night. Pay at trap office.

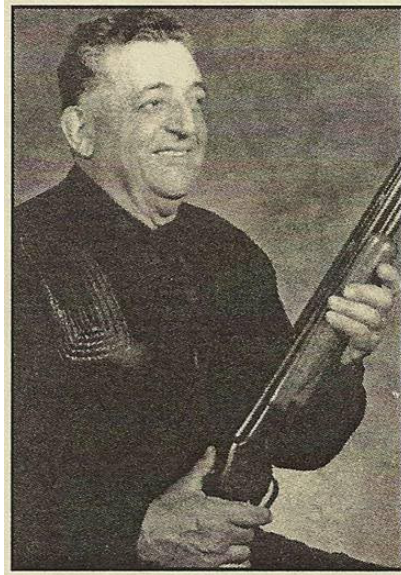
Anyone creating a disturbance or disrupting the harmony of the shoot will be disqualified and asked to leave the grounds.

1909–1987

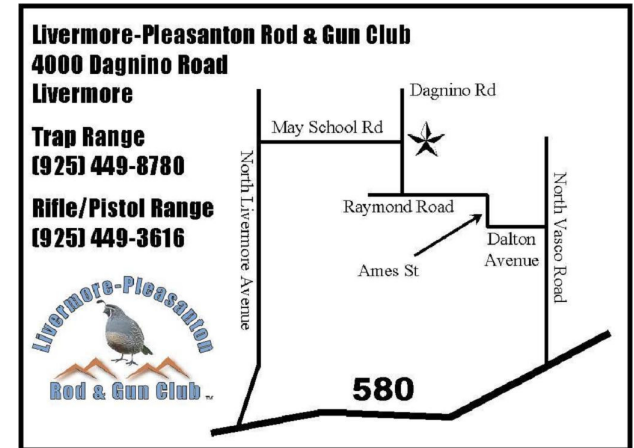

Besides being past-President and perennial Chairman of the club's Board of Directors, Manuel also extended his support to the California State Trapshooting Association as President for two years, to the Pacific International Trapshooting Association as President for two years, and also served as Treasurer of the P.I.T.A. from 1973 until his untimely death in September of 1987. He is very missed.

From Interstate 580:

- Exit at the North Livermore Avenue (Central Livermore) exit
- Travel north on North Livermore Avenue for ~2.6 miles to May School Road
- Turn right on May School Road and travel East for ~1.2 miles to Dagnino Road and the Club's entrance

From the Central Valley or Antioch/Brentwood:

- Take North Vasco Road and turn west on Dalton Avenue, which is ~1.3 miles north of 580 and the North Vasco Road exit.
- Continue on Dalton Avenue for 1.4 miles—Dalton becomes Ames St. then Raymond Rd.
- Turn right (north) on Dagnino Road and in ~0.5 miles, the Club's entrance will be on your right.
