## NRA Training Classes



The Livermore-Pleasanton Rod & Gun Club proudly announces NRA training classes. Whether you own a firearm or not, thinking about purchasing a firearm, or simply want to be safe around firearms, these classes offer the beginning shooter a great start!

The **First Steps Shotgun course** is a 4-6 hour course providing training in firearms safety, ammunition and marksmanship with a variety of shotgun actions. All shooting is done at moving clay targets. The course fee of \$140.00 covers all expenses. Course dates: **Tuesday, June 22** 6:00pm to 10pm, **Saturday, August 14\*** or **Sunday Dec 5** 9:00am to 3:00pm.

The **First Steps Pistol course** is a 6 to 7 hour course providing training in firearms safety, ammunition and marksmanship with both revolvers and semi-automatic pistols. The course fee of \$140.00 covers all expenses. Course Dates: **Tuesday & Wednesday June 14 & 15** (both evenings), 6:30pm to 9:00pm, **Sunday, July 18, Sunday, August 15\***, **Saturday, November 6** or **Saturday, December 4** 9:00am to 4:00pm.

The **First Steps Rifle course** is a 4 hour course providing training in firearms safety, ammunition and marksmanship with a variety of rifle actions. The course fee of \$140.00 covers all expenses. Course Date: **Saturday, August 14\*** 1:30pm to 5:30pm.

Courses marked with an \* comprise a **First Steps "All Firearms" course**. This course combines the fundamentals for the First Steps Pistol, First Steps Rifle and First Steps Shotgun in one course. Preference will be given to students registering for all three courses over single courses.

The **Personal Protection in the Home course** covers defensive handgun skills, firearms laws, levels of awareness, home safety strategies, and responding to violent confrontations. The \$200 course fee covers all range and classroom fees, books, targets, and instruction. Students must provide their own equipment and ammo. One class is offered on **Sunday, November 7**. Class held from 9pm to 6pm.
